Respect Yourself

I will show respect for myself through my actions. I will select online names that are appropriate. I will consider the information and images I post online. I will not post personal information about my life or relationships that can be deemed inappropriate. I will not post or repost content that may include profanity (abbreviations included such as "af, wtf, lmao, etc.), drugs, alcohol, or that is derogatory and/or sexual in nature. I will actively monitor my social media accounts as it is my responsibility and right to erase any comments from peers that fall under the inappropriate content listed above.

Protect Yourself

I will ensure that the information I post online will not put me at risk. I will not publish my personal details, contact details or a schedule of my activities. I will report any inappropriate behavior directed at me. I will protect passwords, accounts and resources.

Respect Others

I will show respect to others. I will not use electronic mediums to bully or harass other people. I will not respond to any negative or inappropriate messages. I will be respectful, credible, and truthful.

Protect Others

I will protect others by reporting abuse and not forwarding inappropriate materials or communications. I will be an advocate for my teammates and realize that defamation of others is illegal.

Honor My Uniform

I will ensure that all images of my uniforms are suitable and reflect the team in a positive light. Uniforms are to be worn properly at all times in all digital posts (buttoned, zipped, and hooked). While in uniform I will not pose or hold up gestures in a manner that may be deemed inappropriate. Posting of non-team members in uniform is not permitted. I will not post images of costumes until I have been given permission by the Director.

Protect My School

I will demonstrate compliance of all school policies and will positively support our school leadership including faculty, staff, and administration.

Protect My Team

I understand that everything I post is a reflection of my team and I will keep in mind that my use of technology has an effect on others. Content I post will be positive and support the goals of the team. I will not use digital media to express my negative emotions. I will contact my coach/director to mediate conflict. I will not post anything that could hurt or jeopardize the reputation of the team.

Consequences for Violation of Social Media Spirit Contract

Each member is required to allow a dance officer and the team account to follow their social media accounts. If a dance officer or President/ Vice president leave a " .-" in the comments section of your post, a member has 24 hours to address the contract violations by editing their social media platform accordingly. 5-15 permanent demerits will be issued based on the severity of the post. Members should not reach out to the officer who assigned the demerits or " .-" unless by appointment in the presence of the director if they would like an explanation. Insubordination after " .-" has been posted to a member's social media account will result in more demerits.

Each member who receives a " .-" symbol must write a paper meeting these guidelines:

1. Paper should be no shorter than 1 page in length, single spacing, 12 pt font, in Arial. The paper must be typed.
2. The paper must include an introduction which summarizes the expectations put forth in the Wildcats Constitution and Social Media Spirit contract each member signed to follow
3. The paper must include 2 paragraphs with a minimum of 12 sentences each (24 sentences in total) addressing
 - Why the member received the " .-."
 - Why the member posted the social media post in question
 - Which part of the spirit contract did you break, why and how?
 - How their actions affect themselves
 - How their actions affects their fellow teammates
 - How they will keep it from happening in the future
 - What they have learned from this experience
